Thought For The Week

Come up here! (Rev. 4:1)Mentioning thrones immediately evokes thoughts of royalty, authority and influence. Thrones are usually higher and more ornately decorated than other seats in view and from them monarchs issue decrees and directives. Once in a while, they invite someone to approach their throne as a mark of favour or



to whisper something confidential. Either way, it is a mark of personal recognition. Prophetic visions in Revelation and other Scriptures variously describe God as seated on a throne high and lifted (see Isaiah 6:1). From there, as the eternal Ruler of all creation, He directs the affairs of the world He created. He is the final arbiter in all matters Who sees and knows everything. He is: "the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honour and might forever. Amen" (1 Timothy 6:15-16). Just imagine yourself, like John and Isaiah, being called up to that glorious throne of God, with blinding lights blazing and fanfare music playing - what an awe-inspiring experience that would be. Well, that is what we will experience physically when Christ comes. But, what if I told you that you do not have to wait that long to experience this glorious encounter? That heaven is beckoning on us daily to "approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need" (Hebrews 4:6). Once again, He says to you, Come Up Here! What a privilege!
