

Thought For The Week

Dear friends, the current Corona Virus (COVID 19) pandemic is one that requires vigilance from all. Follow the advice from government and medical authorities to keep safe. This includes regular hand-washing with soap, not touching sensitive parts of the body including your face, and self-isolation if you suspect anything. Do remember to call 111 or 999 if seriously unwell.



Here in the church, we are very mindful of the dangers that large gatherings pose as potential distribution points for the virus. Although services will continue unhindered, we are taking every precaution to ensure that no one is put at risk. Our Church had long been sensible in adopting individual cups for communion and the bread is already cut to size. So, there is a low risk of infection here. Nevertheless, we need to safeguard ourselves on other fronts. For example, we may need to adopt blow-kissing and waving instead of handshakes, hugs, physical kisses, etc. Also, with the scarcity of sanitizer gels, we have provided antiseptic wet wipes for all to wipe their hands before coming into the church.

Whilst not succumbing to fear, we need to be sensible how we live, physically and spiritually. The Scripture aptly admonishes us in 1 Peter 5:8 to “Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour”. So, let us not fall prey to this virus. Shalom!
